Celebrating Dahl's centenary

FANS of all ages will be able to relive their most magical memories this year, as Roald Dahl's films are brought to life on the big screen.

To celebrate Roald Dahl 100, the centenary year of Roald Dahl's birth, Chapter and [Film Hub Wales](#) are leading a family friendly film programme that will celebrate the world's number one storyteller, born in Cardiff in 1916.

The season runs until the end of

September, with Roald Dahl Day on September 13, celebrating 100 years since Dahl's birth.

August will see an interactive cinematic experience of childhood favourite Matilda, which celebrates its 20th anniversary. For this special event there will be scratch 'n sniff cards provided to accompany the screenings.

There'll also be a week-long workshop in the form of Stinky Flicks, where young people can join in to create an interactive screening of Charlie and the Chocolate Factory.

The project is taking place with the support of the British Film Institute, which has been awarded National Lottery funding, and in collaboration with the Roald Dahl Estate, which is marking the centenary with the Roald Dahl 100, a year packed full of exciting surprises and treats.
